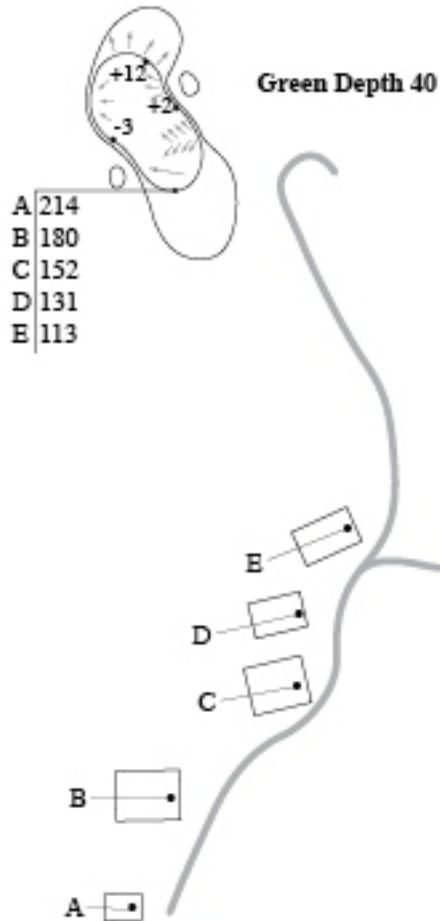

The longest of the four par 3's on the course, number 12 will test your ability to strike the golf ball solidly. Measuring 233 from tips, although downhill, any shot not struck solidly will more than likely find anywhere but the green.

Unless the hole location is front right, the ideal play is to work the ball off the right side of the green with a draw. Your priority should be hitting the green. Hitting from an elevated tee, respect the weather conditions and gusting winds before launching your ball high into the air.

This green is one of the largest on the course and tilts significantly from back to front with a sizeable spine down the center. Take a par and move to the next hole.

Pro's Tip – Par three's are generally not designed as scoring opportunities, but rather situations to display ball striking abilities. The center of the green is always a good place to be, always.
